NIHERST and APETT collaborate to initiate STI transformation projects

The National Institute of Higher Education, Research Science and Technology (NIHERST) and the Association of Professional Engineers of Trinidad and Tobago (APETT) signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) which will see joint collaboration to address engineering-specific societal pain points currently being faced by communities and advance the national agenda for enabling Science Technology and Innovation (STI) in the society

An in-person ceremony was held at the NIHERST Head Office at Education Towers in Port of Spain, between the parties represented by Mrs. Marleen Lord- Lewis-NIHERST, President, and Dr. Chris Maharaj- APETT, President.

Mrs. Lord-Lewis stated, "NIHERST is keen to collaborate with APETT to enable advancements in STI. This partnership will certainly allow our citizens to experience STEM as a tangible benefit through engineering technology solutions that address day-to-day issues within the community."

Standing in agreement, Dr. Maharaj shared, "Such strategic partnerships will indeed serve to improve the quality of life of our people".

The first in a number of activities geared toward resolving engineering-specific societal pain points is the launch of a public education series, in August 2022. The series will discuss engineering challenges such as road maintenance, flooding and renewable energy, to name a few. Members of the public, government, academia and the business community will be invited to participate in this stakeholder session.

With this collaboration, NIHERST is reinforcing its mission to stimulate sustainable national capability and capacity in Science, Technology, Innovation, and Technopreneurship through insightful research and relevant programmes.
